PARKING

Parking is available in the lower-level parking facility of Block 37. Exterior access to the parking facility can be found on [Dearborn Street](#), between Washington and Randolph Streets or by way of the Red and Blue Line CTA stations. Interior access can be found on lower levels B2 and B3, by way of the interior Atrium elevators.

Block 37 has **No FREE parking**. It does have an underground lot, but it is not cheap--*usually*...

However—you can get good deals if you [book and PREPAY](#) your parking for the day! (“Drive-Up” rates are *much* more).

*Garage Entrance on **DEARBORN** — One-Way Street heading NORTH!*

Other key info....

[PARKING.COM](https://www.parking.com) - link where you can pre-buy the parking. Usually, \$12 for the day on a weekend—however, I **do not know exactly**, as the rates do change sometimes (*perhaps based on availability?*)

Pre-paying your parking will generate a link to a QR Code that you can save on your phone. It will be in the email receipt, or follow the link and download image. However, the feature does **NOT** work (*for me, anyway*).



Please NOTE: Scanner for QR code does not seem to work well—be patient, and make sure your phone is 100% brightness. A printout of the code works better.

You can also use this service for other parking garages owned by the same company in the downtown area.

PUBLIC TRANIST [\[CTA\]](#)

If you don't book a hotel within walking distance (*of which there are **MANY***), the best way to get there is to take **public transit** or [UBER](#) / [LYFT](#). The CTA bus would work, but the **CTA "L" Train is best**. It has its two main lines—**Red Line and Blue Line**. Both have a station entrance straight into the mall on the lower level (*blue line requires some "underground navigation"!*)
